Safety at NES

FOOD SAFETY BEFORE, DURING AND AFTER A POWER OUTAGE

Know how to keep food safe before during and after emergencies. Hurricanes, tornadoes, winter weather and other events may cause power outages. Follow these tips to help minimize food loss and reduce your risk of foodborne illness.



Safety Tips After A Power Outage

- Throw away spoiled food
- Check refrigerated medications
- Restock emergency kit

Safety at NES

Remember the PASS Word

Pull the pin (or other motion) to unlock the extinguisher.



Aim at the base (bottom) of the fire and stand 6 - 10 feet away.



Squeeze the lever to discharge the agent.



Sweep

Sweep the spray from left to right until the flames are totally extinguished.

USE THE RIGHT TOOL FOR THE JOB

Operate equipment only if you have been trained on it and operate it in the way the manufacturer recommends. Know the correct use of hand and power tools



WEAR SAFETY EQUIPMENT

Wear safety equipment appropriate to your activity. These can include: hard hats, gloves, eye wear, PPE, respirators, ear protections and more!



KEEP ELECTRICAL ITEMS IN GOOD REPAIR

Do not use electrical equipment while standing or kneeling on wet surfaces. As little as 100 mA can be fatal



CLEAN UP

Clean up spills and remove trip hazards as soon as possible. Remove all loose materials from stairs, walkways, ramps, platforms, etc.



LIFT WITH PROPER TECHNIQUES

Get help to move heavy or bulky materials to avoid injury to yourself or damage to the materials.



STORE MATERIALS SAFELY


Tie down any materials that might fall, roll, or shift. Post weight limits when practical.
